1. B.E./B.Tech & M.E./M.TECH. PROJECT PROPOSAL

PROPOSAL FOR QUALITY ENHANCEMENT OF UG AND PG STUDENTS THROUGH PROJECT BASED RESEARCH, SPONSORED BY INDIAN INSTITUTE OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERS, KOLKATA.

2. APPLICANT ELIGIBILITY

- The applicant must be student/s of B.E./B.Tech and M.E./M.Tech final year in chemical engineering and or allied disciplines and the Supervisor/s are from any AICTE/UGC recognized institutions/universities.
- All the students who will be applying for the project and the guide must be a valid member of IIChE.
- Preference will be given to project proposals that are industry relevant and have potential to lead to an entrepreneurship venture or a start-up model.
- Projects that have thematic focus on any topic of current interest related to Chemical Engineering/Chemical Technology/Polymer science/Biotechnology/Biochemical Engineering will be preferred.
- A project proposal may be submitted either by a single student or by a group of maximum 4 students.

3. FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Maximum fund to be allocated per project shall be Rs. 10,000/- for B.E./B.Tech and Rs. 20,000/- for M.E./M.TECH Students.
- The **fund shall be utilized** for expenditure, which includes raw materials for product fabrication, product testing, etc.
- The **fund shall not be utilized** for travelling expenses, honorarium, scholarship or fee payment and no permanent equipment like computers and peripherals can be procured under this grant.

4. UTILIZATION CERTIFICATE:

- The students/s and their supervisor/s should maintain a book of accounts of all the expenditure incurred under the project and must submit a UTILIZATION CERTIFICATE duly signed by them and approved by the supervisor/supervisor along with the final report.
- The amount should not be utilised for any other purpose other than the project work.
