WORKSHOP PERSPECTIVE

"The Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008 " is gazetted in September, 2008 and therefore, will be in force in 2009. There had been fierce debate when the Draft Rules dated 28 September, 2007 was circulated in supersession of Hazardous Waste Rules, 1989, and its subsequent Amendments. Industries, NGOs, Media and enforcing Authorities participated to suggest changes and this resulted in publication of new Rules, 2008. This new Rules has many facets and therefore, clear understanding by Industries and Academia is essential prior to implementation of the Rules.

With this objective, Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers, Calcutta Regional Centre (IICChE,CRC) and Indian Chemical Council, Eastern Region (ICC,ER) have jointly embarked on to organise 2-Day Workshop which will focus on

- ❖ Better Understanding of new Rules
- ❖ Enabling Recovery of useful materials from Hazardous Waste destined for final disposal
- ❖ Sound management of all Hazardous Wastes, and
- ❖ Source reduction of Waste rather than end of the pipe solution

It will also take into account aspects like

- e-Waste
- Waste arising out of Lead-Acid Batteries, non-Hazardous Industrial Waste
- TDSF for Hazardous Waste and
- Addressing Sustainable Development Concerns

West Bengal Pollution Control Board have very kindly agreed to provide experts, technical assistance as well as make it a forum to listen to Industries and Academia.

Workshop is planned to be interactive and will bring eminent Specialists, Professionals and Activists in this field as well as distinguished experts from Industries and Institutions for guidance, comments and explanation

Further discussions are likely to take place regarding Benchmarking of Generation of Waste in this part of the Country and how the performance fares against other Regions, Existing Facilities available in this Region for Disposal of Hazardous Waste and Way Forward.

The Workshop is first of its kind on the said new Rules in Eastern Region and will mainly cover Manufacturing Industries viz. Chemical, Petro-Chemical, Thermal Power Generating Units and Iron (e.g. Sponge Iron Manufacture) Industries including IT and Small and Medium Entrepreneurs. The emphasis will be on Management of Solid Waste (Hazardous and non-Hazardous).

The Workshop will commence at 9-30 A.M., It is planned for one full first day and is likely to be concluded by 3pm next day.
