### CATEGORIES:

- Category I : Undergraduate students.
- Category II : Post graduate students, Research Scholars & Working Professionals (Below 35 yrs)

### RULES –

- All teams or individual participants are initially required to submit a written synopsis. (Team should not exceed three members).
- Shortlisted teams / individuals will be called to make power point presentation to a panel of judges.
- All participating teams / individuals are required to be present on the day of presentation.
- The written synopsis should cover the important highlights (4 to 5 pages on A4 size paper on one side)
- All presentations shall be property of IChE MRC and it will reserve the right to publish them.
- The decision of IChE MRC Award Committee will be final in all matters relating to this competition.

### ELIGIBILITY & EVALUATION CRITERIA -

- Individuals or teams with max. **Three members per team** from the Chemical Engineering disciplines, including students. (MBAs with Chemical Engineering degrees are also welcome)
- Age of individual or team members – 35 years or below
- Oral Presentation and Q&A session – 20 to 25 minutes
  - Coverage and depth of the presentation.
  - Balance among various presentation components.
  - Appropriate treatment of vital points / issues.
  - Presentation flow.
  - Teamwork, where applicable.
  - Effective handling of the questions put by the judges.
  - Overall presentation skill.
