## **THE INSTITUTE**

The Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers was founded on May 18, 1947. Late Dr Hiralal Roy, the founder of chemical engineering education in India, was the Founder President and it was through his initiative, vision and endeavour, that the institute came into being. Like many other institutions, it also started in an humble way with only 30 members, but with the passage of time it expanded both in number and its activities and the Institute can now justify its claim to be the main forum of chemical engineering profession in the country, with more than 13000 members and 36 Regional Centres. The Institute is a body registered under the Societies Registration Act, 1961.

## **MAJOR OBJECTIVES**

- To promote the advancement of Chemical Engineering Science;
- To advance professional standards and to imbibe and maintain ethical practice among its members in professional conduct and dealings;
- To act as an anchor for the professional interests of Chemical Engineers in general and members of the Institute in particular, and to do all things necessary in connection therewith;
- To serve as lead and supreme body on all matters pertaining to the teaching and profession of Chemical engineering for continuous upgradation of the standards;
- To initiate conferences and to transact business on administrative, academic and technical matters relating to the profession of Chemical Engineering;
- To encourage and financially support research in Chemical Engineering;
- To conduct examinations and prescribe syllabi and to award diplomas and certificates;
- To grant national awards, scholarships, prizes to selected professionals, young scientists, academics and peer groups for their contribution to national advancement;
- To publish and maintain an organ of the Institute, and similar other publications;
- To assist necessitous members and dependents of the deceased members.

## **ELIGIBILITY FOR ORGANISATIONAL MEMBERSHIP**

Organisations and Institutions interested in development of Chemical Engineering profession and its application to Chemical industries may be elected as Organisational Members of the Institute.

## **PROCEDURE FOR ADMISSION**

Organisations and Institutions desirous of joining as Organisational Members shall make a written request to that effect, to the Council of the Institute addressed to the Secretary giving information about the organisation. The applicant shall be declared duly elected after such request is considered and approved by the Council.

## RIGHTS AND PRIVILEGES OF ORGANISATIONAL MEMBERS

1. Maximum Four delegates (depending upon the annual turnover of the Organisational Member) will be allowed to attend the annual conferences of the Institute (CHEMCON), waiving the requirement of the delegate fees.
2. A copy of the Institute's Journal - INDIAN CHEMICAL ENGINEER, will be posted to Organisational members, without any charge.
2. They shall be kept informed of all programmes of the Institute regularly, and their official delegates shall be allowed for programmes such as short-term Technical Courses, Continuing Education Courses, Technical Symposia, Seminars, etc. involving delegate fees, at a concessional fee of 75% of the normal rates for such programmes. IChE Regional Centres shall be advised to do likewise for programmes organised by them.
4. The interaction between the Organisational Members and the Institute will certainly help the chemical engineers in, general and the chemical industries in particular.
5. Vacancies for the posts of chemical engineers will be published as News Items in the Institute's journal.
6. Technology development by the Organisation in the field of Chemical Engineering and allied subjects will be published as News Items in the Institute's Journal.
7. For new Organisational Members, the Company Profile not exceeding one page will be published free of cost in the Institute's Journal.
8. For Life Organisational Members and others regularly renewing the membership, the company Profile, not exceeding one page, will be published free of cost once in 3 (three) years in the Institute's Journal.
9. Name and Profile of the Chief Executive of the Company with his photograph will be published free of cost in INDIAN CHEMICAL ENGINEERS whenever there is a change.
10. If the Organisational Member releases advertisement in the "INDIAN CHEMICAL ENGINEER" 10% rebate on tariff will be given.
11. The Chief Executives of the Organisations, whose turnover are 100 Crores, will be elected as patrons of the Institute and subscriptions for the same would not be charged.
