## 1.0 Introduction

The report covers major activities of the Institute during the period 1 April 2020 to 31 March 2021.

## 2.0 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual Session and CHEMCON 2020

The 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual Session of Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers (IIChE), i.e., Indian Chemical Engineering Congress (CHEMCON 2020), was jointly organized by the Headquarters of IIChE and the Hyderabad Regional Centre of IIChE during 27 - 29 December 2020 through digital mode. The central theme for this year's CHEMCON was 'Exploring Recent Trends in Chemical Engineering'.

CHEMCON 2020 was inaugurated by **Prof. K. Vijay Raghavan**, Principal Scientific Adviser to the Government of India, who was the Chief Guest for the event. The Guests of Honours for the Inaugural Programme were **Prof. V. V. Basava Rao**, President, IIChE; Padma Shri **Prof. G.D. Yadav**, former President and former Vice Chancellor, ICT Mumbai; **Prof. S. Venkateshwar**, former President, IIChE and **Shri. Ch. Satyanarayana**, Chairman, Inventaa Industries Pvt Ltd.

Of the three prestigious Memorial Lectures, **Dr. H.L. Roy Memorial Lecture** was delivered by **Prof. Bala Subramaniam**, University of Kansas (KU) USA; Aker **Powergas's Prof. N.R. Kamath & Mrs. Ruzena Kamath Memorial Lecture** was delivered by **Dr. R.R. Sonde**, Vice President, Thermax and **Inventaa C K Murthy Memorial Lecture** by **Prof. Debangsu Bhattacharya**, West Virginia University, USA.

There were two panel discussions, held on 'Atma Nirbhar Bharat: Role of Engineers on Indigenization' and 'Vocal for Local: A Necessity for the Country's Growth'. Mr. Praveen Saxena was the moderator for both the sessions. Thirteen distinguished panellists participated in the discussions.

The Dhirubhai Ambani Commemoration day, another leading event under the CHEMCON umbrella, was observed on 28 December. Dr. Renu Swarup, Secretary, Department of Biotechnology, Government of India was the Chief Guest on the occasion. She made a presentation on 'New Emerging Technologies & Tools: Driving the Bioeconomy Growth'. The Guests of Honour<del>s</del>, who were present online, were Prof. V. V Basava Rao, and Padma Shri Prof. G. D. Yadav.

CHEMCON 2020 came to an end with the Valedictory Address by Prof. Georges Belfort, Member, US National Academy of

Engineering. The Guests of Honour for the session were Shri Raj Nair, Chairman, Avalon Consulting Ltd. and Dr. K Sainath, Managing Director, Clair Engineers Pvt. Ltd. Chairpersons were Prof V.V. The Valedictory Session concluded with Vote of Thanks, given by the two Organizing Secretaries, Dr. Avijit Ghosh and Dr. Sanjay Bhardwaj.

## 73<sup>rd</sup> Annual General Meeting

The 73<sup>rd</sup> (seventy-third) Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Institute was held on December 28, 2020 at the Osmania University, Hyderabad. Prof. V. V. Basava Rao, President of the Institute for 2020, chaired the meeting. The AGM was attended by 84 Corporate Members offline and online.

 Adoption of 72<sup>nd</sup> AGM Minutes: The minutes of the 72<sup>nd</sup> (Seventy-second) Annual General Meeting, held on December 17, 2019 at Indian Institute of Technology, Delhi, were confirmed, as proposed by Prof. N. Balasubramanian and seconded by Prof.B. B. Paira.

- ii. Adoption of EGM Minutes: The meeting adopted the minutes of the EGM of the Institute as proposed by Prof.
  B. B. Paira and seconded by Dr. K. B. Radhakrishnan, held online on October 28, 2020.
- iii. Ratification of Revised amendments of Constitution: The revised amendments of the IIChE Constitution, as approved by the Council 2020, were placed in the meeting. Certain points of the amendments were confirmed at the AGM as proposed by Prof. Vinay Kumar Srivastava and seconded by Mr. Bhaskar Reddy with some changes in the clauses. The rest of the items of the revised amendments were decided to be considered when a physical meeting would be held in the near future.
- iv. Adoption of the Annual Report for 2019-2020 and Adoption of Audited Statement of Accounts (2019-2020): The Honorary Secretary briefly presented activity reports of the Regional Centres and the Students' Chapters, conducted throughout the reporting year. He also briefed about all the meetings (Council meetings and Sub-committee meetings), conducted during 2020 in the prevailing COVID 19 situations. The meeting unanimously adopted the Annual Report of the Institute and audited statement of the Accounts as proposed by Mr. C P Ramulu and seconded by Dr. Sanjay Bharadwaj.
- v. **Suspension of Paradeep RC**: Members unanimously decided to suspend Paradeep Regional Centre as it was non-functional for long, not responding to queries from the Headquarters and had not submitted Annual Accounts for the FY 2018-19 and 2019-20 along with the Annual Reports of activities.
- vi. Appointment of Auditors: The meeting decided to appoint K. Jana & Associates, Chartered Accountants, (South End Conclave, Unit – 005, Ground Floor, 1582, Rajdanga Main Road, Kolkata – 700107) as the Auditors of the Institute for the financial year 2020-2021 to handle the IIChE Headquarters Accounts and the IIChE Consolidated Accounts as well as all tax related matters.Their remuneration was fixed at Rs. 35,000/- + GST.
- vii. Miscellaneous:
- a. Prof Sunil Baran Kuila was inducted as a Council Member for the year 2021 to fill up a vacancy from the Eastern Zone. His name was proposed by Mr. Ranga Rao and Seconded by Prof. M. K. Jha.

b. The members approved the proposal by the Honorary Secretary to increase the number of Honorary Fellows of the Institute from 125 (as laid down in the Guidelines of the Constitution) to 150. The members requested the Honorary Secretary to include this point in the Constitution amendments (2020).

Moreover, it was also recommended that in a year a maximum of two (02) Honorary Fellowships will be awarded by the Institute.

c. The provision of SBI e-collect was adopted for all types of payment, to be received at the Headquarters.

The members conveyed their gratitude to the President, Prof. V. V. Basava Rao and the Honorary Secretary, Dr. Avijit Ghosh, particularly for streamlining and reforming the overall accounting process of IIChE.

Council further decided that the next election for the RCs would be held in 2021. Therefore, those RCs, whose election is due in 2020, will be requested to defer it till 2021. Accordingly, the existing EC of the RCs would continue till 2021.

#### **Online Summer Internship Program**

The Council was apprised of the online summer internship program (4 -6 weeks), initiated in May, 2020, for the UG

students of Chemical Engineering and / or allied disciplines. During the prevailing pandemic situation, the academic calendars for students were thrown completely out of gear all across the globe. As engineering students were unable to undertake on-site summer internships, AICTE had advised online summer trainings for the students as an alternative. IIChE introduced this Internship Program in line with the AICTE advisory.

The competent authority had decided to utilize the total revenue generated out of this training program as follows:

- 60% would be spent to conduct the training program and create facility for the digital conference room at headquarters. A separate webpage and IIChE Apps would be created for the training program and certificate course with online test and certificate printing.
- 40% will be fixed deposited as the corpus fund for such type of training programs / certificate courses in future at the IIChE headquarters.

The Council appreciated the President and the Honorary Secretary for initiating the Internship Program, which had evoked great response from the students.

## Mini Project Grant for UG/PG students

The Council approved the proposal for a small amount of research grant, to be offered to the Under-graduate (20 projects) and Post-graduate (10 projects) students for their innovative research work. The idea is to encourage the student's community to become a member of the institute. The members of the Council were informed that 70% of the total funding amount for the project could be generated from the membership drive.

## **Donation to PM-CARE Relief Fund**

The IIChE Headquarters donated Rs. 1,00,000/- (One Lakh) to the PM-CARE Relief Fund, which was created for dealing with the Covid disaster. This donation amount was adjusted from the travel allowance of the Council Members for the year 2020. A few of the RCs also donated to the fund through the IIChE headquarters. Those Regional Centres were: Northern Regional Centre (Rs 10, 00,000), Trivandam Regional Centre (Rs. 10,000), and Pilani Regional Center (Rs. 5,000).

Service Rule Amendment

Based on the minutes of the meeting (30 June 2020) of the Service Rule Amendment (SRA) Committee, the Council adopted the following clauses in the IIChE Service Rule, to be effective from July 2020 following confirmation of an employee at the IIChE Headquarters.

- The service of any regular employee on probation period would be governed by the terms and condition of a new Service Rule, which would be effective from January 2022.
- The employees, who are at present on probation period, would not come under the existing pension scheme of the IIChE. They would only be entitled to the CPF as per the new Service Rules with effect from January 2022.

## Modification of Online Membership Form

Due to the ongoing Covid-19 pandemic, it was decided to consider online application forms for the new membership in order to boost membership drive of the Institute. As part of the process, membership number would be allotted after verification from the Accounts Department.

In this context, the Honorary Secretary pointed out that certain modifications (endorsement in the corporate/life membership application form, forwarding of the student membership application form, etc.) might be required in the existing membership form for accommodating the online mode of application. The Council approved of modifications in the online membership application form as per the requirement.

#### Fellowship

Based on the recommendations of the Honorary Fellowship Committee, the Council decided to award Honorary Fellowship to Dr. Bidhan Chandra Bag (DRDO, Nagpur) and Prof. Mihir Purkait (IIT, Guwahati).

## Emergent Council Meeting 2020, held online on 16 August, 2020

## **Council Election 2020**

In the event of the ongoing Covid crisis, the 4<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council (18 July 2020) had decided that an Emergent Council Meeting would be held on 16 August, 2020 to take the final decision for holding the Council Election 2020 on the basis of the recommendation of the Prof. M.V Rao committee, constituted for this purpose.

Based on the recommendation of the referred committee, the Council took the following decision:

"Council to postpone the IIChE Council Election 2020 by one year, i.e., up to 2021 and the term of council, which is getting completed in 2020, may also be extended by one year, i.e., up to 2021".

The Council also decided to get this decision regarding postponement of the 2020 Council Election ratified at an Extraordinary General Body (EGB) Meeting and/or in the AGM, which may be conducted through online in due course of time.

## Administrative Matters

## **Opening of New Regional Centres, Student Chapters**

The Council approved the proposal for accepting only online application form for opening Regional Centres and New Student Chapters. The form is to be available from the IIChE website (<u>www.iiche.org.in</u>). No offline application would be considered in future.

## **Regional Centre Affairs**

The Council decided to merge Damanjodi Regional Centre with the Bhubaneswar Regional Centre. However, the members of the Damanjodi RC will be free to choose any RC to join according to their choice.

#### Fellowship

Based on the recommendations of the Honorary Fellowship Committee, the Council decided to award Honorary Fellowship to Prof S.K. Majumder (IIT, Guwahati).

## Extraordinary General Meeting, held online on 28 October, 2020.

The EGM unanimously ratified the council decision to postpone the IIChE Council Elections, scheduled for the year 2020, by one year, i.e., upto 2021. Accordingly, the term of the Council, getting completed at the end of 2020, was also extended by one year, i.e., upto December 2021.

## 6.4 6<sup>th</sup> meeting for 2020, held at Osmania University, Hyderabad on 27 December, 2020.

### **IIChE Constitution Amendment**

The Council discussed the final recommendations of the Constitution Amendment Committee-2020 (CAC-2020), which had been compiled after intense delibrerations at several meetings of the CAC-2020. Finally, the Council unanimously

decided to ratify the revised recommendations of the CAC-2020 at the AGM 2020.

## Fellowship

Clause 4 in the Guidelines of the IIChE Constitution provides for not more than 125 Honorary Fellows at a time. Already the number of Honorary Fellows in IIChE has reached 125. Therefore, subject to ratification at the AGM-2020, the Council unanimously decided to increase the maximum number of Honorary Fellow of the Institute to 150. Also, it was decided to award Honorary Fellowship to only two eminent persons in a year.

## **Financial Matters**

As per GST Act, GST should be charged for all categories of Membership. So far, the membership fees (Life Associate Membership, Life Membership and Organizational Membership) were charged without adding the GST amount.

The Council decided that GST wil be chargeable for all categories of membership w.e.f January, 2021.

## **Organisational Membership**

The Council approved the Life Organisational Membership of B.I.T Sindri, Jharkhand and Agile Process Chemicals LLP, Mumbai.

## **Student Chapter Affairs**

#### New Students Chapters

The Council approved the formation of Students' Chapter at the Department of Chemical Engineering, SDM College of Engineering & Technology, Dharwad under the Bangalore Regional Centre and VSSUT, Burla under the Rourkela Regional Centre, subject to the fulfilment of the criteria as laid down in Student Chapter By-laws.

## **AMIIChE Examination**

The Council decided to indefinitely postpone the September semester of the Associate Membership Examinations 2020 semester (theory papers) due to the COVID 19 pandemic.

## 11.0 Students' CHEMCON

#### 14.0 Beyond March

As per the convention, the Annual Report of the IIChE Headquarters has covered activities of the Institute for the financial year April 2020 – March 2021. However, we deem it would be appropriate to keep our valued Members posted about important activities of the Institute that were conducted after March 2021.

**Online Internship Program - 2021**: Following encouraging response last year, the second edition of the Online Internship Program (OIP-2021) was initiated in February 2021. Held in several batches, there was very positive feedback about the OIP-2021 from the students. Courses were offered in eight subjects, namely, Six Sigma (Yellow Belt); Chemical Process Technology; Petroleum Refinery Engineering; Project Management; Petrochemical Engineering; Process Safety Management; Zero Liquid Discharge Management and Biochemical Engineering.

**GATE Coaching by Vani Institute**: IIChE has formed collaboration with the Hyderabad-based Vani Institute of Engineering & Technology for GATE and ESE coaching at the IIChE Headquarters in Kolkata. The IIChE Student Members will get an additional 5 – 10 per cent discount.

**Collaboration with SIT**: IIChE signed an MoU with Siddaganga Institute of Technology (SIT), Tumakuru in July 2021 for establishing a Risk Management Centre of Excellence (RMCoE) at Tumakuru, India. IIChE will be involved in matters of professional outreach for the RMCoE. Specifically, IIChE will focus areas, such as, effective curriculum delivery, research, development and policy advisory.

*Collaboration with Terra Green Technologies:* Another important collaboration has been forged between IIChE and Terra Green Technologies Private Ltd., Kolkata for offering Online Industrial Start-up Internship.

**SCHEMCON 2021:** The 17th session of the Students' CHEMCON (SCHEMCON) was organized on 22 and 23 October 2021, jointly by IISER, Bhopal and MANIT, Bhopal with the active support of the IIChE Headquarters. The central theme for this year's SCHEMCON was 'Globally Advancement in Technology for Environment 2021' (GATE -2021).

**CHEMCON 2021:** Indian Chemical Engineering Congress & the 74th Annual Session of Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers (CHEMCON 2021) is scheduled to be held during 27–30 December 2021 in Bhubaneswar. The Bhubaneswar Regional Centre of IIChE and CSIR-IMMT, Bhubaneswar are organizing CHEMCON 2021 in association with ICT-IOC, Bhubaneswar.

**ACMS-2022:** IIChE will be celebrating its Platinum Jubilee in the year 2022. The Institute Headquarters is gearing up for the year-long celebration of the Platinum Jubilee in a befitting manner. The inauguration of the year-long celebration will be marked with an International Conference under the title of 'Advances in Chemical and Materials Sciences (ACMS-2022)', to be organized in Kolkata during 24 to 26 February 2022. The event will be organized in association with National Institute of Technology (NIT) Jalandhar; Heritage Institute of Technology (HIT), Kolkata and Osmania University College of Technology, Hyderabad.
