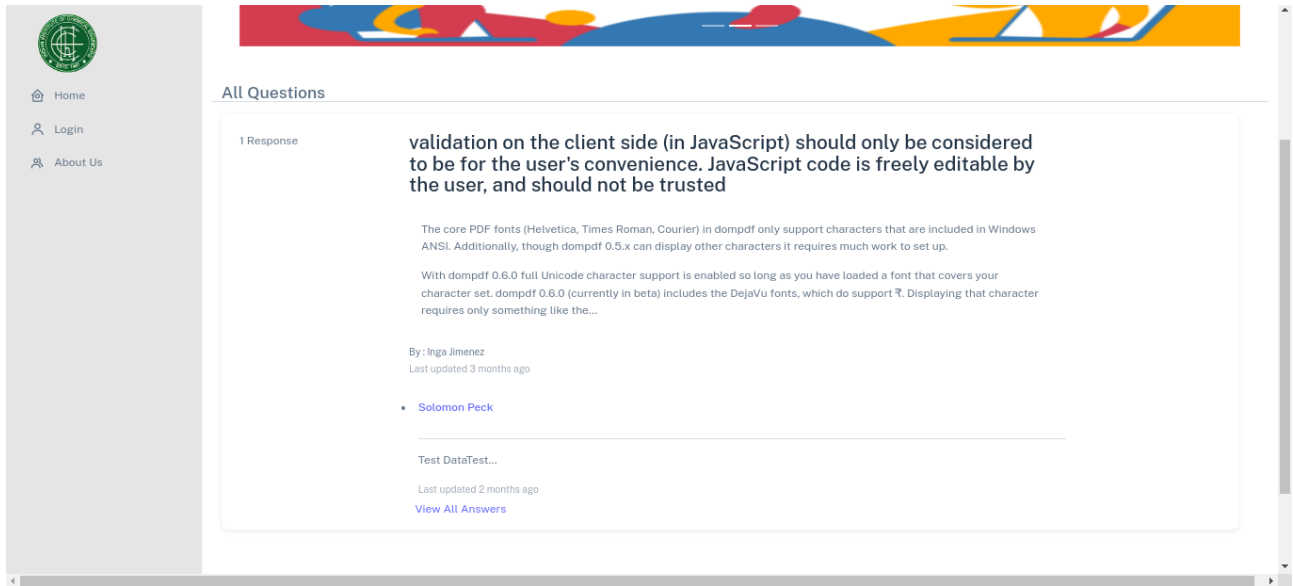
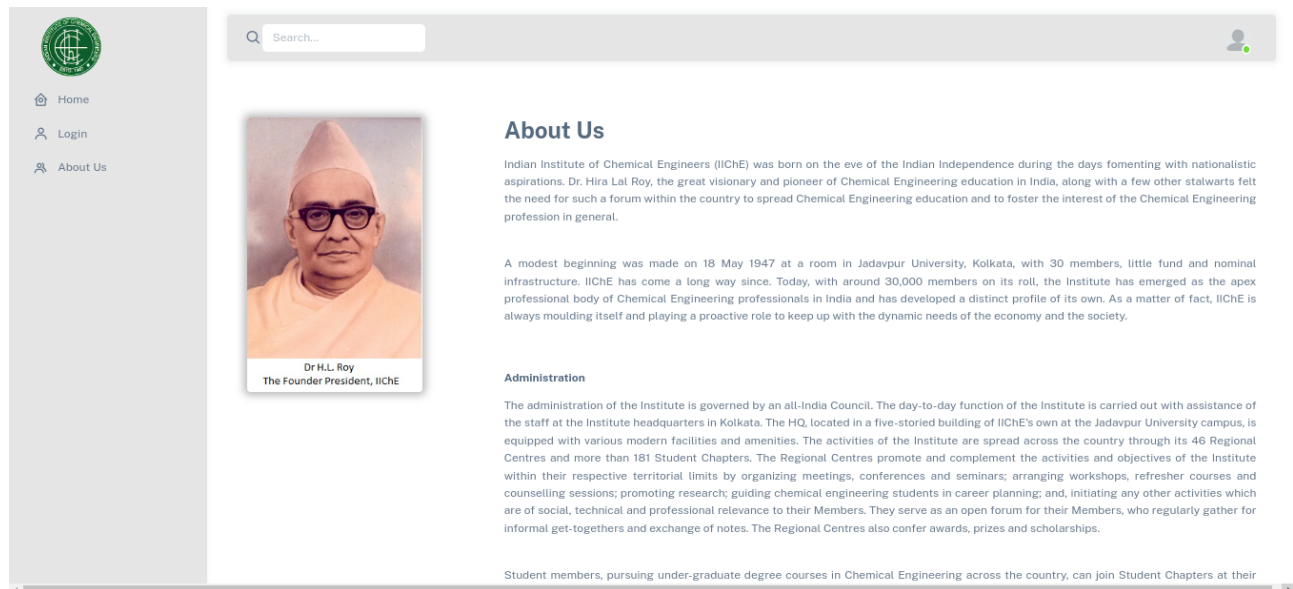

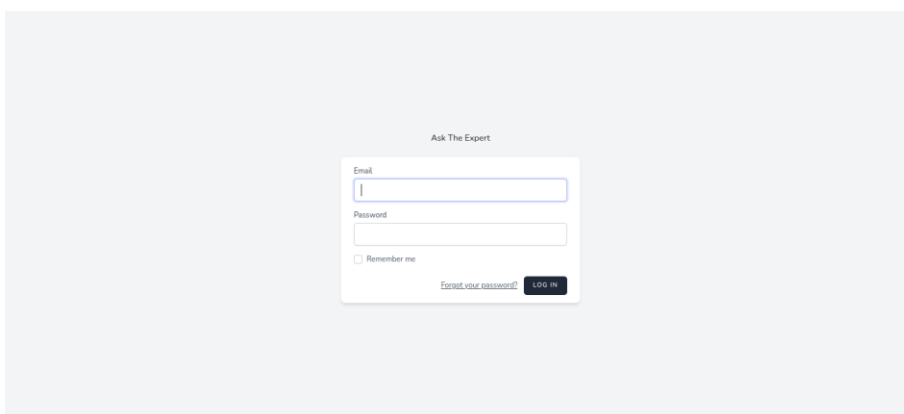

## Login Page


In login page Expert, User, and Admin can login.

6. and Confirm Password

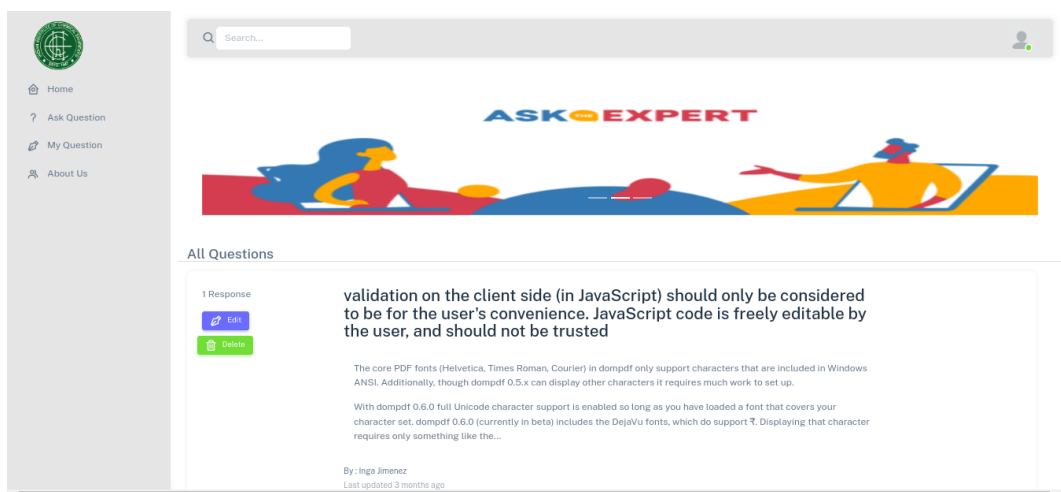

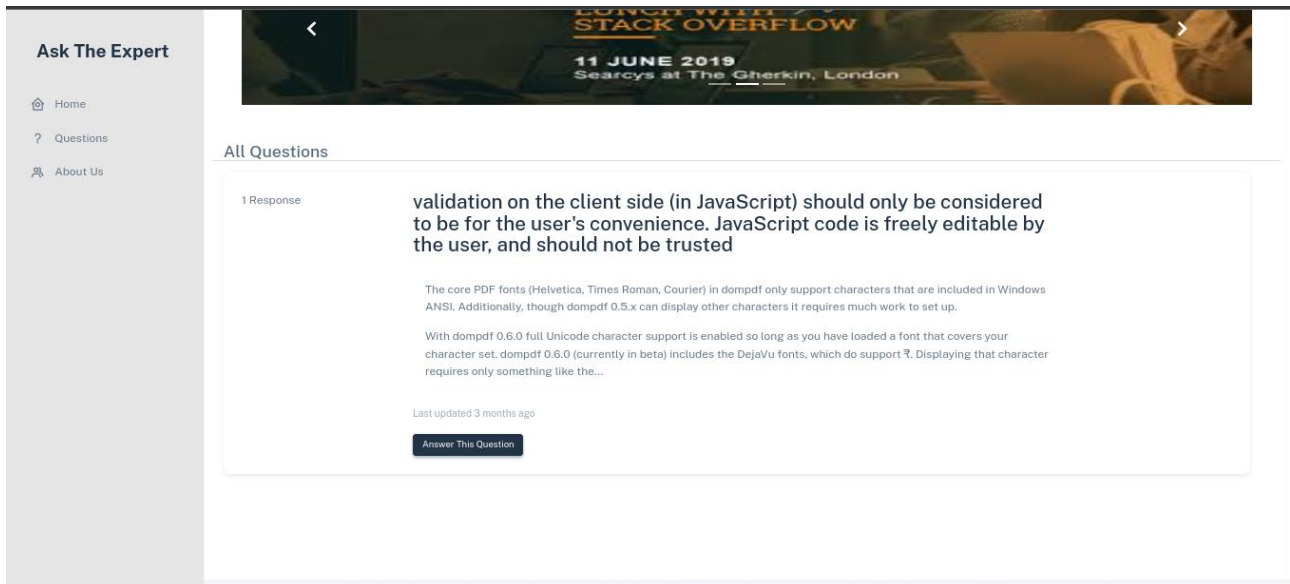

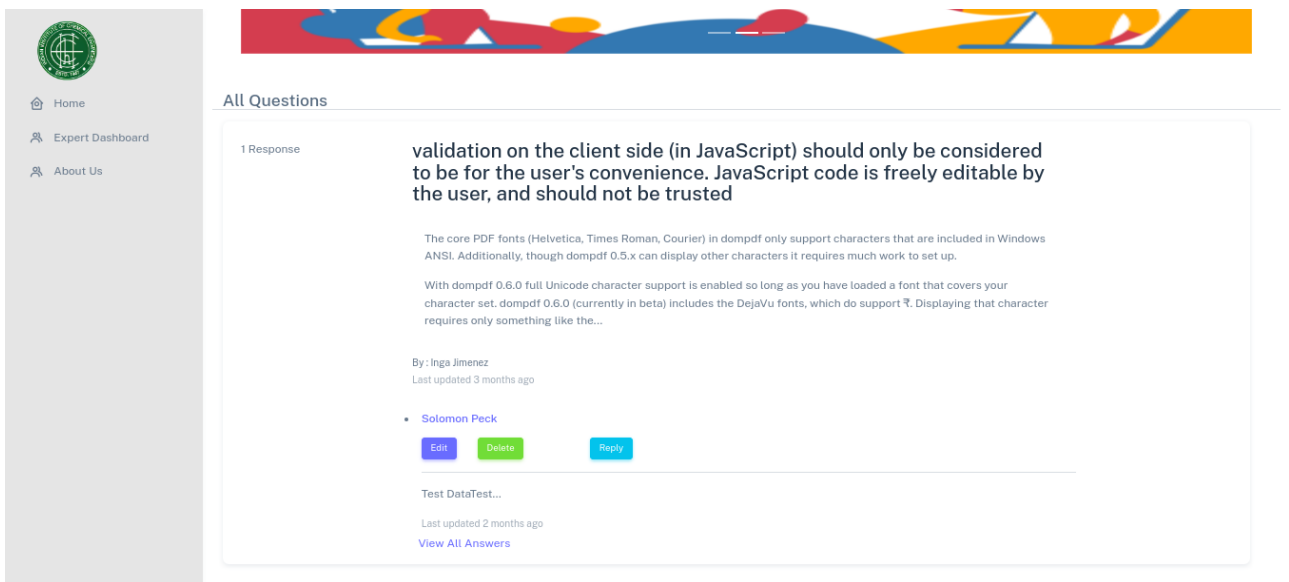
