1.0 Introduction

The report covers major activities of the Institute during the period 1 April 2017 to 31 March 2018.

2.0 70th Annual Session and CHEMCON 2017

The 70th Annual Session of Indian Institute of Chemical Engineers (IIChE), i.e., Indian Chemical Engineering Congress (CHEMCON 2017) was organized at Haldia by Haldia Regional Centre of IIChE during 27 – 30 December 2017 in association with the Department of Chemical Engineering of Haldia Institute of Technology (HIT) and supported by Department of Biotechnology & Food Technology of the same Institute. The central theme for this CHEMCON was 'Versatility of Chemical Engineering to Meet Societal Changes'.

The Chief Guest, Dr. U. Kamachi Mudali, Chairman & Chief Executive, Heavy Water Board, DAE, Government of India inaugurated the event on 27 December 2017 by lighting a lamp. Other dignitaries, who were present, included Prof. G.D.Yadav, VC, ICT, Mumbai, and Chairman, National Organizing Committee, CHEMCON 2017; Prof. P. De, President, IIChE; Mr. Dipak Dutta, Hony. Secretary, IIChE; Prof. Radha Das, Organising Secretary, CHEMCON 2017; Dr. L. Seth (Ex MP & Chairman, HIT); Mr. A.P.,Gangopadhyay, Former ED, IOCL, Haldia and Chair of the Organizing Committee; Mr. A.K. Ghosh, EVP-Head Plant, HPL; and Chairman. Prof. P De delivered the Presidential Address and presented the IIChE awards.

The inaugural function was followed by presentation of the three Memorial Lectures by renowned authorities in the field of chemical engineering. Dr. H L Roy Memorial Lecture, sponsored by Jacobs, was delivered by Dr. Asoke Dey Sarkar, Chairman, PfP Industries LLC, USA on 'Convergence in Education & Entrepreneurship in Work'. The second lecture, Aker Powergas's Prof. N.R. Kamath and Mrs. Ruzena Kamath Memorial Lecture was delivered by Prof. Sadhan C. Jana, Chairman, Department of Polymer Engineering, University of Akron on 'Changing Landscape

in Polymer Research: Role of Chemical Engineers', and Inventaa C.K. Murthy Memorial Lecture was delivered by Ms. Sheela, Dy. Chief Executive, (Z & SM), Nuclear Fuel Complex, Hyderabad on 'Role of Chemical Engineers in Atomic Energy to Serve Society'.

As customary, December 28, 2017, the birth anniversary of the late Shri Dhirubhai Ambani, was celebrated as Shri Dhirubhai Ambani Commemoration Day in association with Reliance Industries Limited. Dr. Baldev Raj, Director, National Institute of Advanced Studies, delivered the Dhirubhai Ambani Oration on 'Energy Sustainability in India: Challenges and Opportunities'.

During the event, around 400 Technical Papers were presented in 27 parallel sessions, including two poster sessions. along with 16 Chemcon Distinguished Speaker (CDS) award lectures (listed in Section 8.0).

Joint Symposia: Indo-Canadian Joint Symposium on 'Chemical Engineering in Development of Energy and Environmental Technologies' and a special Joint Symposium on the theme of the conference 'Versatility of Chemical Engineering to Meet Societal Challenges' were held. Academics from many overseas universities, including, University of Akron, USA; University of Alberta & York University, Canada; University of Sydney, Australia; Morelia Technological Institute, Mexico; National University of Singapore; KU Leuven, Belgium; Queens University Belfast, UK; University of North Carolina, USA; National University, San Diego, USA; and Shizuoka University of Japan were present at CHEMCON.

A long list of IIChE awards were presented on the occasion, which included the following two prestigious National Awards

Firstly, the Dr B P Godrej Life Time Achievement Award was conferred upon Mr. D P Misra, Past President, IIChE and a Distinguished Chemical Engineer.

Secondly, Lala Shriram National Award for Leadership in Chemical Industry was conferred upon Dr. Purnendu Chatterjee, Chairman, Haldia Petrochemicals Ltd. and TCG Life Science Group in appreciation of his long contribution towards Chemical Engineering profession in the country.

3.0 70th Annual General Meeting

The 70th (seventieth) Annual General Meeting (AGM) of the Institute was held on December 28, 2017 at the Haldia Institute of Technology, Halida. Prof P De, President of the Institute for 2017, chaired the meeting and called the meeting to order. It was attended by 50 Corporate Members. (A list is presented in the back inside cover page).

The minutes of the 69th (Sixty-ninth) Annual General Meeting held on December 28, 2016 at A C Tech., Anna University, Chennai, which was circulated on November 16, 2017 by Mr Dipak Dutta, Honorary Secretary, were confirmed, as proposed by Prof S C Naik (Bhubaneswar) and seconded by Dr D Gokul (Chennai).

The meeting unanimously adopted the Annual Report of the Institute for the period between April 01, 2016 and March 31, 2017 as circulated.

The meeting thereafter adopted the Audited Statement of Accounts for the year 2016-17 of the Institute unanimously.

During the previous AGM (69th AGM, held in 2016), the members had decided that Regional Centres, which would fail in submitting their respective audited Account and Annual Report in time and in prescribed format, would be suspended and their bank accounts would be sealed. Members empowered the Council to revoke suspension order on defaulter Regional Centres, provided the defaulting Regional Centres submit Annual Accounts and Annual Reports to the Headquarters in proper formats and with due signature by the office bearers. The AGM approved revocation of the suspension order on Waltair and Ahmedabad Regional Centres.

The meeting decided to appoint K R A G & Associates, Chartered Accountants, 87, Golf Club Road, Tollygunge, Kolkata- 711 102, West Bengal as Auditors of the Institute for the financial year 2018-2019 at an annual remuneration of Rs. 22,000/-.

The names of the newly elected Council members for the period 2018 - 2020 were announced. The Members welcomed the elected members for joining the new Council.

The members agreed about collecting the latest contact details of the IIChE members from the CHEMCON 2017 register so that the Headquarters could update its list for voter registration.

The members discussed the possibilities of merger of certain awards for which enhancement of endowment is not available.

Prof P De, President thanked the Council members, the members of the Executive Committees of Regional Centres as well as of Students Chapters and the members of the institute for extending sincere help and co-operation for all activities during the year.

The members conveyed their gratitude and thanks to the President and outgoing Council members for the services rendered during the year for the growth of the Institute.

4.0 R&D Activities by IIChE HQ

The Institute is recognized by the Department of Science and Technology, Government of India, as a Scientific and Industrial Research Organization. Some of the major R&D projects concluded by the Institute in recent times include:

- Parametric optimization and control of semi-batch reactor for sulfonation process.
- * Green route synthesis of cadmium sulfide quantum dots.
- Treatment of coke oven waste water using hybrid technology.
- * Flow of emulsion through porous media.
- * Supercritical fluid extraction of natural products from various plant residues.

Research work on 'Hydrodynamics of tapered bubble column' was carried out by Mr Sandip K Ghosh, Assistant Secretary – Research & Professional Development', IIChE with the permission granted by his employer. The research work was carried out at the Department of Chemical Engineering, University of Calcutta under the supervision and guidance of Prof. Amitava Bandyopadhyay, a Life Member of IIChE.

Administrative

R&D Vision

Members were appraised of the salient features of the 'R&D Vision and Strategy of IIChE' as submitted by Prof B P Mandal, Convener of the R&D Committee.

The Council deliberated and approved a sum of Rs 5.0 lakh for 2017 and requested the R&D Committee to take appropriate action for finalizing and monitoring the research projects to be carried out on behalf of IIChE following the guidelines stated in the R&D vision document.

Financial

GST: The Honorary Secretary reported that as advised by the CA of the IIChE Headquarters, GST registration would

have to be state-wise, i.e., one GST number for one state. Hence, there is no provision for Centralized registration of GST. Moreover, in case of more than one Regional Centre in a state, one Regional Centre would have to take responsibility for other centres in the concerned state.

Council Members, in principle, approved the decision of migration from Service Tax to GST. For Centralized Registration of GST and other necessary formalities, Honorary Treasurer informed the Council that he would consult with other lawyers.

Closure of Bank Accounts of CHEMCON and SCHEMCON: Due to stringencies of Income Tax Rules, the Council decided that henceforth Bank Accounts of CHEMCON and SCHEMCON would be closed after the congress and a closure certificate from banks would have to be forwarded to the Headquarters for submission to Income Tax Authority at appropriate time.

6.4 6th meeting for 2017 held at Haldia Institute of Technology, Haldia on December 26 and 27, 2017

Constitutional By-law Amendment

The Council approved the following amendment to clause no. 8.2 of Bye-laws of Regional Centre.

The Vice-chairman, Honorary Regional Secretary, Honorary Joint Regional Secretary, Honorary Regional Treasurer and all the Executive Committee Members shall have to hold the office for two years to become eligible for re-election to the Executive Committee.

Before the amendment, the office bearers had to hold office for one year to become eligible for re-election.

Awards

- The Council decided that henceforth no awardee would be given more than one prize for one paper.
- ii. The Council was informed by Hony. Secretary that as per Prof. G.D. Yadav's request, Shri Rajjubhai Shroff, Chairman, UPL had agreed to donate an additional amoun of Rs. 8.0 Lakh towards endowment of UPL Chemcon Distinguished Speaker Award. In the process, he had also suggested to rename the referred award as UPL Smt. Sandra R Shroff Chemcon Distinguished Speaker Award. Accordingly, the total endowment value for the award would come to Rs10.0 Lakh with effect from 2018, it was pointed out.

The Council put on record its deep appreciation for the kind gesture extended by Shri Rajjubhai Shoff, and also the efforts made by Prof. Yadav in enhancing the endowment.

6.5 1st meeting for 2018, held at Haldia Institute of Technology, Haldia, on December 29, 2017

Election of the President

The members elected Prof. Vinay K Srivastava as the President of the Institute for the year 2018.

Election of two Vice-Presidents

Prof S P Chaurasia and Dr Ajay Bansal were elected as the Vice-Presidents of the Institute for the year 2018.

Election of Other Office Bearers

For the year 2018, the members elected Prof S K Das as the Honorary Secretary of the Institute. Mr M Ranga Rao as the Honorary Jt Secretary; Prof M S Rao as the Honorary Treasurer; Mr Dhawal Saxena as the Honorary Registrar; and Dr M Rajasimman as the Honorary Controller of Examinations, were elected by the members.

In accordance with the provision under clause 25.4 (b) of the Constitution and decision of the Council in its fourth Meeting for 2015, held on 11 July 2015, Prof. S Basu was appointed as Honorary Editor of the Institute for a period of 5 years with effect on and from 1st January 2018. He would be an ex-officio Member to the Council of the Institute for the year 2018.

Vision for the Future

Prof P De, the outgoing President of the Institute, briefed the members about certain initiatives that the Council had undertaken in the recent past. Significant issues that he urged the new Council (2018) to pursue in the coming year are as follows:

- * Certification of 'Competent Chemical Engineer':
- * Six-sigma Training: Program that should be started as soon as possible; initially at the major Regional Centres.
- * FICCI-IIChE initiative: Once the proposal, submitted to the Ministry, gets approved, IIChE has to start working in the desired direction immediately. Council would have to decide on the modalities beforehand.
- * The Council would have to work diligently to develop and strengthen IIChE's relationship with AICTE.
- * UPSC: The communication, already initiated with UPSC to include Chemical Engineering as a subject for IES examination as well as for recruitment in other Central Government. Organizations, has to be followed up for positive result.
- * Professional Events: The Council would have to consider

- organizing one or two programmes, i.e., seminars, conferences, etc. at Headquarters and also at other Regional Centres in order to enhance visibility of the Institute and generate revenues.
- * Renovation of Headquarters Building: Dr. H L Roy Building, where the Headquarter is based, is in a bad shape. Renovation work is in progress, which involves huge expenditure. In this connection, requests have been made to Ankleshwar, Hyderabad, Mumbai and Northern Regional Centres for donating Rs. 5.00 lakh each to carry out the repairing work.
- * Digitization of the office work: The process is already underway and it has to be completed at the earliest opportunity. This would not only help reduce expenditure but would also increase the overall efficiency of the office.
- * Organizational Members: Council would have to pay due attention to bring in more organizations under the umbrella of the Institute as 'Organizational Member'. During 2017, altogether 12 Organizational Members were enrolled.
- * AMIIChE Examination: Overhauling of the whole examination process, including curriculum and syllabi, conforming to the requirement of AICTE, has already been started. The process needs to be completed at the earliest.
- * R&D Drive: Emphasis should be given on a concerted campaign for development of a low-carbon sustainable economy through research and development, keeping in view IIChE's R&D Vision 2030, which was adopted in 2017 itself.
- * R&D Directory: A Directory of Research Projects, underway in different organizations, related to Chemical Engineering and allied subjects, would have to be prepared and uploaded on the IIChE website.
- * A Directory of students graduating as Chemical Engineers from various colleges in India would have to be prepared.
- * Partnerships: IIChE would have to forge partnerships (MoU) with organizations, such as, CII, OTAI, etc.

Administrative

Account Maintenance: For the purpose of filing income tax returns, it was decided that Regional Centres would be required to provide monthly income / expenditure statements to the Headquarters, supported by bills and vouchers. However, in this connection, the Council considered the difficulties, to be faced by the Regional Centres, in providing the same due to absence of a dedicated account assistant at most of the Regional Centres. Subsequently, the Council decided that each RC should provide the supporting bills and vouchers annually in-time.

It was also decided that Regional Centres would be required to send copies of their documents of all properties, such as, buildings/ land / FDs, etc., to the Headquarters.

GST: Council noted that the Headquarters and Regional Centes, such as, Northern RC and Mumbai RC, have got GST registration for transactions within their respective states. While suggesting the Headquarters to further study the actual scenario, the Council also recommended that state-wise GSTs should be done by other leading Regional Centres so that all the major Regional Centres come under the ambit of GST within their respective states.

Award

Institution of New Awards: The Council approved institution of two new awards from 2018.

i. P K Nair Memorial Award (Biennial): Criterion for the Award will be 'Excellence in Design/ Development of Process Plant / Equipment in a continuous Chemical Process unit by a Chemical Engineer'. Age limit for the candidate will be below 45 years. The awardee will be given Rs. 25,000/-, a memento and a certificate.

The award has been instituted by Dr Madhu Nair in memory of his father late P Karunakaran Nair.

ii. Prof. Shyamal Kanti Sanyal Memorial Award for the Best PhD Thesis in the Area of Membranes Research with Significant Commercial Potential:

11.0 Students' CHEMCON

Report on the Financial Statements

1. We have audited the accompanying financial statements of INDIAN INSTITUTE OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERS ('the Institute'), which comprise the Balance sheet as at 31st March, 2018, the statement of Income & Expenditure Account for the year ended on that date and a summary of significant accounting policies and other explanatory information of HEAD QUARTER and other REGIONAL CENTRES & STUDENT CHAPTERS audited by others. The financial statement has been prepared by management of INDIAN INSTITUTE OF CHEMICAL ENGINEERS and it is maintained in electronic form.

Management's Responsibility for the financial Statements

2. The management is responsible for the preparation and presentation of these financial statements that give a true and fair view of financial position and financial performance of the Institute in accordance with the accounting principles generally accepted in India. This responsibility also includes maintenance of adequate accounting records in accordance with accounting convention for safeguarding the assets of the Institute and for preventing and detecting frauds and other irregularities, selection and application of appropriate accounting policies; making judgments and estimates that are reasonable and prudent; and the design, implementation and maintenance of adequate internal financial controls, that were operating effectively for ensuring the accuracy and completeness of the accounting records, relevant to the preparation and presentation of the financial statements that give a true and fair view and are free from material misstatement, whether due to fraud or error.

Auditors Responsibility

- 3.1. Our responsibility is to express an opinion on these financial statements based on our audit We have taken into account the provisions of the accounting and auditing standards and matters which are required to be included in the audit report under the provisions of the relevant act and rules made there under.
- 3.2. We conducted our audit in accordance with the Standards on Auditing, issued by The Institute Of Chartered Accounts of India. Those Standards require that we comply with ethical requirements and plan and perform the audit to obtain reasonable assurance about whether the financial statements are free from material misstatement.
- 3.3. An audit involves performing procedures to obtain audit evidence about the amounts and the disclosures in the financial statements. The procedures selected depend on the auditor's judgment, including the assessment of the risks of material misstatement of the financial statements, whether due to fraud or error. In making those risk assessments, the auditor considers internal financial control relevant to the Institute's preparation of the financial statement that gives a true and fair view in order to design audit procedures that are appropriate in the circumstances, but not for the purpose of expressing an opinion on whether the Institute has in place an adequate internal financial controls system over financial reporting and the operating effectiveness of such controls. An audit also includes evaluating the appropriateness of the accounting policies used and the reasonableness of the accounting estimates made by the Institute's management, as well as evaluating the overall presentation of the financial statements.
- 3.4. We believe that the audit evidence we have obtained is sufficient and appropriate to provide a basis for our audit opinion on the financial statements of the Institute.

Opinion

- 4. In our Opinion & to the best of our information and according to explanations given to us, the said financial statements read together with the notes thereon and Statement of Significant Accounting Policies gives the information required by the members in the manner so required & give a true & fair view in conformity with the Accounting Principles generally accepted in India,
 - i) In the case of consolidated Balance Sheet, of the state of affairs of the Institute as at 31st March, 2018; and
 - ii) In the case of Consolidated Income and Expenditure Account, surplus of the Institute as at 31st March 2018.

Emphasis on the Matter

Without qualifying our opinion, we draw attention to the following matters ::

- 5. Suspense accounts amounting to Rs. 23,50,544.25 representing the defalcation occurred pertaining to year 1991-92
- 6. Accumulated Balance of Income Tax deduction at source, aggregating Rs. 105,65,667/= shown as good, the recoverability of which is very much doubtful as the documents for claiming TDS are not available.
- 7. Institution is currently registered under section 12A of the Income Tax Act, 1961. CBDT has rejected the application for renewal of registration under section 35(1)(ii) of the Income Tax Act, 1961 and the matter is still subject matter of dispute under the income tax law, inter alia, there is a demand of Rs. 32,23,096 raised by the AO, Kolkata for the assessment year 2009-10, against which the institute has preferred an appeal before CIT(A)-XIV. We refer note no. 2(a)(ii) of Annexure H.
- 8. We observed that consolidated financial statements have been prepared in electronic form and such consolidation of different accounts of RCs and Student Chapters have been verified on sample basis.
- 9. Fixed Assets and Investments, belongs to RCs and Student Chapters have not physically verified by us.
- 10. We observed in the accounts regarding non submission of Audited Accounts of the Regional Centres as stated in Annexure H, "Notes on Accounts" and we are unable to express our opinion on the effect of non incorporation of said accounts in the Income & Expenditure and on the Balance Sheet of the Institute.
- 11. Loans and Advances of Rs. 116,17,531/- includes amount receivable and considered good of Rs. 50,24,433/- in the audited account of SEMINAR BOMBAY remains receivable since the financial year 2011-12. We are not in a position to comment on the recoverability of the same.
