### 0.0 Condolence

To pay homage to Prof S L Narayanamurthy (LM 00989) who has passed away on 14.10.2019 at an age of 78, a silent prayer for a minute was observed by the members of the Council.

### 1.0 Leave of Absence:

The Council granted leave of absence to Prof A Bandyopadhyay regretting his inability to attend the meeting.

### 2.0 Confirmation of Minutes

Minutes of the 5<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Council for 2019 held on 17 & 18 October, 2019 at Ankleshwar, were confirmed.

### 3.0 Matters deferred from earlier and those arising out of previous meetings

#### 3.1 Ref Item No. 3.1 of the 5<sup>th</sup> Meeting for 2019 held at Ankleshwar

Prof. V.V. Basava Rao, convener of the service rule amendment committee circulated the draft amendment amongst the members through email on dated 11.12.19. After a long deliberation, the members decided to defer it to the next meeting.

### 4.0 CHEMCONS & SCHEMCONS

#### 4.1 CHEMCON 2017 Accounts related matters

Mr. Ranga Rao, Member, High Power Committee, reviewed the documents received from the Haldia Regional Centre on 14.10.2019 at IChE HQ. Mr. Rao submitted a brief report to the council. It has been observed that CHEMCON 2017 organizer has not rectified the bills and/or works order based on the data supplied by the Members of Haldia Regional Centre on 19.08.2018 to Prof. Chaurasia Committee and to Prof A.K. Mitra Committee. Prof. Radha Das, Organizing Secretary and Dr. R. N. Jana, Treasurer of CHEMCON 2017 accepted their mistake in the accounts in the high power committee meeting held on 1<sup>st</sup>



September 2019 under the Chairmanship of President IChE and they agreed to submit the corrected accounts after rectifying the earlier mistakes/short-comings. (**Annexure (MOM High power committee) –1**). However, no significant rectification has been made in the revised account submitted to IChE HQ after the meeting with High Power Committee on 01.09.2019.

The Council deliberated thoroughly on this issue and taken the opinion of every council member present in the meeting. To avoid legal implications, financial issues, income tax matters and also to close long pending issue, the council unanimously decided the followings:

- 1) Haldia Regional Centre (Address: Department of Chemical Engineering, Haldia Institute of Technology, Haldia) has not adopted and followed CHEMCON protocol procedures.
- 2) The CHEMCON 2017 audited accounts submitted by LOC and forwarded by the then Honorary Secretary of Haldia RC, would be provisionally considered for placing before the appropriate authority for the accounting purpose.
- 3) Any queries raised by the IT departments and any authorized experts based on accounts submitted by LOC, Haldia Regional Centre, it will be sole responsibility of HRC to bear all penalties and IT dues related to CHEMCON 2017 accounts.
- 4) As Haldia RC has not fulfilled all requirements of CHEMCON 2017 account. Haldia Regional Centre located in the Department of Chemical Engineering at Haldia Institute of Technology will not be given any program/activities like SCHEMCON/CHEMCON etc. from IChE Head Quarter at least for next 10 years. (**Annexure –II CHEMCON Bid form**: Where it is mentioned that if any differences in opinions are raised, the decision of the President will be final).
- 5) The CHENCOM 2017 Organizing Secretary (Prof. Radha Das) and Treasures (Dr. R. N. Jana) shall not be allowed to contest in the executive committee of Haldia Regional Centre EC as well as in the council election of IChE Head Quarter in future, as council is not satisfied with their accounts submission in spite of repeated reminders over period of two years.
- 6) Council decided to revoke the ban on HRC-IChE functioning with immediate effect and allowed to do its general activities' under the supervision of Honorary Secretary, IChE.
- 7) The expenditures incurred by HQs for conducting High Power committee meetings; Management Audit, etc may be borne by the Haldia Regional Center. The amount will be deposited into Head quarter account at the earliest and not later than May 31<sup>st</sup> 2020.

#### 4.2 CHEMCON 2018

Revised annual accounts were received from Doaba Regional Centre. It would be reviewed and would be reported in the next council meeting.

#### 4.3 CHEMCON 2019/ Dhirubhai Ambani Commemoration Day

- 4.3.1 Members noted that as per guide lines of CHEMCON, the Local Organizing Committee should submit a report on the Conference within a month to the Council and the audited



statement of accounts by 31<sup>st</sup> March. It was also noted that the report should include (based on the recommendations of the Chairpersons of Technical Sessions) the names of the authors of the Best Technical Papers presented in each Technical Session of CHEMCON.

- 4.3.2 Council decided that the sponsorship amount receivable from Reliance Industries Limited (RIL) would be distributed between Northern Regional Centre and Jaipur Regional Centre in the ratio of 40:60, respectively. Moreover, it was also decided that in future only IICHe HQ would communicate to RIL for the sponsorship to the CHEMCON.

#### 4.4 **CHEMCON 2020**

Council decided to send a letter to the organizing secretary of CHEMCON 2020 with a request to follow the CHEMCON protocol. Prof. S. C Naik would look in to the matter and report to the council if any differences in opinion arise.

#### 4.5 **CHEMCON 2021**

Council approved the BID received from Kanpur Regional Centre and hence CHEMCON 2021 would be hosted by Kanpur RC.

There are several requests for organizing CHEMCON 2022, however, the year 2022 will be platinum Jubilee year of IICHe, the council opinioned that it may be organized at IICHe Head Quarter with the complete cooperation and participation of all the past & present council members, and regional center Chairpersons to improve the financial position of head quarter. The final confirmation would be taken as per the existing precedence of taking decision in last council meeting of 2020.

#### 4.5 **SCHEMCON 2019**

Council noted the report of SCHEMCON-2019 as received from SCHEMCON 2019 organizers and advised HQ to make follow-up for receiving the audited statement of accounts.

#### 4.6 **SCHEMCON 2020**

Council noted that no communication was received from the organizer after the 5<sup>th</sup> Council meeting 2019.

#### 4.7 **SCHEMCON 2021**

Bids for organizing SCHEMCON 2021 was received from Dr S Suresh, Assistant Professor & Head of the Department, MANIT Bhopal, Madhya Pradesh (vide his email of 07.09.2019) as given in **Annexure-III**. Council further decided that the department could become organizational member and would directly attach to the IICHe HQ. The matter would be reviewed after receiving their response. They could also attach to a nearby RC. A letter would be sent from the IICHe HQ with the request to attach with nearby regional centre. (It would be further discussed in the next council meeting).



## 5.0 Administrative Matters

- 5.1 Council approved the recommendations of the Disciplinary Committee (**Annexure-IV**) with minor changes (Point-7 in the annexure-IV) that the designation of Mr. Soumen Nath would be as Assistant Manager in other section (Except account). The Council authorised Honorary Secretary to issue an office order to Mr. Soumen Nath in accordance with the recommendations of the Disciplinary Committee followed by Council decision.

### 5.2 *Recovery of Excess Payment credited to IChE Account*

Council noted that Excess payment of Rs 2,76,991/- made to M/s Art & Architecture was recovered by IChE HQ with the help of Admin Committee and credited to Bank Account of IChE on 16.11.2019. The council appreciated the efforts of building committee and honorary Secretary.

### 5.3 *Annual Report of Regional Centres*

The Regional Centres who have not submitted their annual report as on date are Dehradun, Dhanbad, Durgapur, Goa, Kalpakkam, Lote-Parasuram, Mangalore, Pondicherry & Pilani.

One reminder email would be sent to Dehradun, Dhanbad, Durgapur, Goa, Kalpakkam, Lote-Parasuram, Pondicherry & Pilani for submitting the annual report by 15<sup>th</sup> February 2020 failing which particular RC would be merged with the nearby active regional centre.

### 5.4 *Annual Accounts of Regional Centres*

The Regional Centres who have not submitted their Annual Accounts in due time are Damanjodi, Dehradun, Dhanbad, Durgapur, Goa, Kalpakkam, Paradeep and Pondicherry. Hence the same could not be incorporated in the consolidated accounts for the FY 2018-2019.

Council decided that Assistant Secretary will contact to the respective Chairmen/Secretaries for getting the Reports by 15<sup>th</sup> February 2020 failing which particular RC would be merged with the nearby active regional centre. Council suggested that the head quarter should be more pro-active in this regards.

Council also noted that Pondicherry RC and Kalpakkam RC have audited their accounts 2018-19.

## 6.0 Financial Matters

- 6.1 Council decided not to increase cash limit from Rs. 5000/- to Rs. 10000/- for day to day expenditure.
- 6.2 Regarding appeal case for the AY 2017-2018 and on the question of law for the AY 2019-2020 whether or not income tax paid in previous year 2018-2019 shall be considered as eligible expenses in calculation of 85% expenditure, legal opinion is suggested by our Auditor to be taken from Mr. Sanjay Bhattacharjee, Senior CA. The cost for legal opinion is around Rs. 12,000/-.

Council approved the cost for the legal opinion from Mr. Sanjay Bhattacharjee, Senior CA.





## 7.0 Publication

- 7.1 Prof. S. Basu, Honorary Editor informed the council that Prof. Sathyanarayana N Gummadi, Professor, IIT Madras had given his kind consent in place of Prof Karthikeyan to act as an Associate editor for the Biochemical and Biotechnology division of ICE.

Council approved the appointment of Prof. Gummadi as an Associate Editor, Division: Biochemical Biotechnology.

- 7.2 Council decided to hold an editorial board meeting during the CHEMCON in every year. The Editor, Associate Editors, Chairman of the publication committee would be invited by the CHEMCON organizers to deliver an invited talk and/or chair a technical session. It would help to the members of the editorial board to get official leave. Moreover, no financial support would be given for the editorial board meeting to the members by the IIChE.

## 8.0 Awards

- 8.1 Council accepted the recommendations received from the appropriate authorities in respect of different Awards (National Awards/Other Awards) for the year 2019 as listed in **Annexure-V**.

### 8.2 National Awards

- 8.2.1 Council noted that Lala Shriram National Award was given to Mr Rajendra Gogri, Chairman and Managing Director of Aarti Industries Ltd based on the recommendation of expert committee.
- 8.2.2. Council decided to hold 6 CDS lectures at NIT Jaipur during the celebration of Dhirubhai Ambani Commemoration Day.

### 8.3 National Awards/Student Awards

Council decided to write a letter to Prof Ashutosh Sharma for changing the criteria of Best Research Paper Published in National Journal to Best Research Paper Published in **International** Journal by both Undergraduate and **Post Graduate** Students

Therefore, the Student Chapter could open an account for the specific program with the prior permission from head quarter. The subvention amount would be sent to that account for the specific program. The account should be closed after the completion of the program and audited accounts should be submitted within 30 dates from the date of completion of the program.

##### 14.2 *Global Disaster Relief Fund (Corpus)*

A letter dated August 27, 2019 has been received from Mr R Narasimhan (LM 01179), Ex-Chairman, CRC, Chennai addressed to Prof S V Satyanarayana, President, IIChE for creating a relief fund for providing assistance and relief to the Bhopal Gas Tragedy Survivors and families of victims.

Council decided that it would not be possible to create a relief fund in the present financial scenario at the IIChE HQ.

Council approved the same.

##### 14.4 *Professional Engineers Bill" organized by AICTE*

Mr. Shyam Bang, Past President, IIChE attended the Workshop entitled "**Professional Engineers Bill" organized by AICTE** on 11.02.2019 on behalf of IIChE and had given his observation (email) on 14.02.2019 and 15.02.2019. Prof. Naik was requested to prepare the document in the 3<sup>rd</sup> Council Meeting held on May 18, 2019 for which he was provided with all the documents in this regard. Prof. Naik will update the matter vide his email dated 05.09.2019.

The matter deferred to the next meeting.






## Recommendation by the "Disciplinary Committee"


